PACKING LIST

- 1. Current medication list, to include dosage dose schedule
- 2. Calling card for long distance phone calls, if desired (none needed for Children & Adolescents)
- 3. Cash for vending machines, if desired limited to \$40 (Child & Adolescent program excluded)
- 4. One to two week's supply of factory sealed tobacco products (Child & Adolescent program excluded)
- 5. Up to three items of reading material (must be approved by Program Director)
- 6. One to two changes of full coverage sleepwear to be worn in bedrooms only
- 7. Three to four changes of clothing (no inappropriate language, pictures, or sayings on clothing; no strings, no sleeveless or spaghetti straps, no tight fitting or revealing clothing; no excessive metal decorations)
- 8. Athletic shoes without laces and physical fitness clothing without strings for daily workout (active duty military only)


Contraband List

(To ensure unit safety the following items are not permitted)

- 1. Weapons of any kind
- 2. String of any kind (shoelaces, clothing ties, etc)
- 3. Metal of any kind (razors, paper clips, staples, spiral notebooks, metal cans, safety pins, 3 ring binders, nail files/clippers, scissors, metal hair clips, etc.)
- 4. Jewelry (except wedding band)
- 5. Plastic bags, aerosol sprays
- 6. Boots
- 7. Bath sponges, net "scrubbies"
- 8. Belts, suspenders, and overalls
- 9. Toiletry items (all toiletry items are provided)
- 10. Cosmetic items in metal, glass, or hard plastic containers, or containers with mirrors.
- 11. Hats, hair coverings, and sunglasses
- 12. Electronic or battery operated equipment of any kind (to include E- Cigarettes)
- 13. Musical instruments of any kind
- 14. Any writing instruments (pens, pencils, markers, etc.); necessary items will be provided
- 15. Outside food or drinks
- 16. Stuffed animals (unless approved by physician for children)
- 17. Personal bedding and pillows

<u>Please note:</u> Clothing that is excessively loose, tight or revealing will not be tolerated!

All belongings that exceed packing list or are deemed to be contraband will be secured in a sealed bag until discharge. This is not an all-inclusive list; any item deemed potentially dangerous will be secured by staff until discharge.
